Extension Homemakers to sponsor Open Class Exhibit

Ripley County Extension Homemakers will again sponsor Open Class Exhibits at the Ripley county 4-H Fair in Osgood. Projects will be accepted Saturday, July 20, from 9 a.m. until noon at the Homemakers Building.

Any adult resident of Ripley County or member of Ripley County Extension Homemakers or person doing most of their business in Ripley County is eligible to participate in Open Class judging. There are a wide variety of categories to enter. The fair committee will be careful in handling exhibits but assumes no responsi-

bility for loss or damage. The Homemakers Building is staffed at all times while the doors are open.

Each exhibitor may have more than one entry in a class or subclass but can only win one entry per class. All entries must be made by the exhibitor within the last year and not shown at a previous Ripley County Fair. Exhibits can be claimed from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. on Friday July 26, at the Homemakers Building. All remaining exhibits will be at the extension office for two weeks after the fair.

A 1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbon will be awarded to each project. A monetary prize will be given to the champion and reserve champion in each section. Judges decisions will be final.

Entries will not show names before judging but will have name and awarded ribbon for display after judging. Professional projects are separate categories and will be judged separately.

Professional projects will be displayed in its own area.
