Indians at a glance...



Last year, the Indians were known for their breakneck speed and long-range shooting ability, capped by a strong inside presence from Ripley Publishing Company's Wm. "Tiny" Hunt Award winner Orrin Schmidt. Although Schmidt graduated along with two hot shooters Joel Norman and Damon Ward, the gold and black are bringing back several key players




Raiders at a glance...
