Notice is hereby given, that the Town of Versailles, Ripley County, Indiana, by and through its Town Council, hereinafter referred to as the Owner, will receive sealed bid packets for the construction of the TOWN OF VER-SAILLES MAIN STREET RESURFACING PROJECT.

Sealed bids must be received by the Town of Versailles (P.O. Box 436, Versailles IN 47042; Town Hall 128 North Main Street. Versailles IN 47042) no later than 3:30 P.M. (Local Time) on Monday, February 10, 2020. No late bids will be accepted and bids received after such hour will be returned unopened. Bids received prior to this time shall be opened and publicly read at the public meeting scheduled to take place on February 10, 2020 at 6:00 P.M. at the Town Hall. All interested citizens are invited to attend and should any citizens require special provisions, such as handicapped modifications or non-English translation personnel, the Town will provide such provisions as long as the request is made 1 week prior to the meeting.

The Town of Versailles Main Street Resurfacing Project consists of, but is not necessarily limited to, the resurfacing of Main Street, with patching of sections as required, and the replacement of concrete sidewalks and curbs along sections of the street. Approximately 12,100 S.Y. of milling and 1.5" HMA resurfacing overlay, 3500 L.F. of sidewalk, ramp and curb replacement shall be required.

All work must be completed within 120 calendar days of award of contract.

The work to be performed and the bid to be submitted shall include sufficient and proper sums for all general construction, mechanical installation, labor, materials, permits, licenses, insurance, and so forth incidental to and required for the construction of the facilities.

Each bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the title of the Project and the name and address of Bidder. All bids must be submitted on the bid forms as identified in the Contract Documents and Specifications.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a bid guaranty conforming to the Indiana Revised code. Said bid guaranty shall be a certified check in an amount equal to FIVE percent (5%) of the Bid; or a bid bond for FIVE percent (5%) of the Bid as surety for the execution of the contract. The bond or certified check should be made out to the Town of Versailles. A bid bond form is included in the bidding documents.

Approved performance and payment bonds guaranteeing faithful and proper performance of the work and materials, to be executed by an acceptable surety company, will be required of the Contractor at the time of contract execution. The bonds will be in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price and must be in full force and effect throughout the term of the Construction Contract plus a period of twelve (12) months from the date of substantial comple-

The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid, or all bids, or to accept any bid or bids, or to make such combination of bids as may seem desirable, and to waive any and all informalities in bidding. Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof. Any bid received after the time and date specified shall not be considered. No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least ninety (90) days

A conditional or qualified Bid will not be accepted. Award will be made to the low, responsive, responsible bidder.

All applicable laws, ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the project shall apply to the project through-

Bids shall be properly and completely executed on bid forms included in the Specifications. Bids shall include all information requested by Indiana Form 96 (Revised 2010) included with the Specifications. Under Section III of Form 96, the Bidder shall submit a financial statement.

Each Bidder is responsible for inspecting the Project site(s) and for reading and being thoroughly familiar with the Contract Documents and Specifications. The failure or omission of any Bidder to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation with respect to its Bid.

Successful bidder shall be prepared to have all project bonding and insurance in place and be able to sign the construction contract on, or before, February 20, 2020.
