So far this year, the Indians have defeated county opponents Batesville by a score of 73-63 on Dec. 19. That game was played at Batesville and was a back-and-forth affair, the 10-point spread being created thanks to late-game free throws by Milan. The Indians are averaging about 65 points per game, led by an 85-point performance against South Decatur on Dec. 13. Last year, Milan defeated SR in the opening round of the RCT 62-60 but fell in the final to Batesville 65-48. 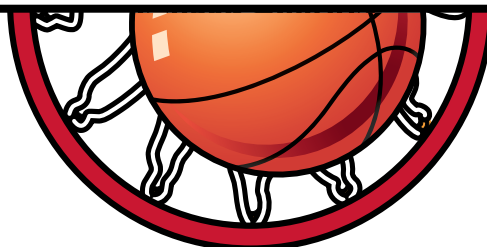

The Lady Eagles are averaging about 53 points per game, 35 rebounds per game, and 12 assists per game. They have an equal ability to shoot from long range or work the ball inside, capped by strong ball handling. The team is currently ranked 10th in Class A by Sagarin. 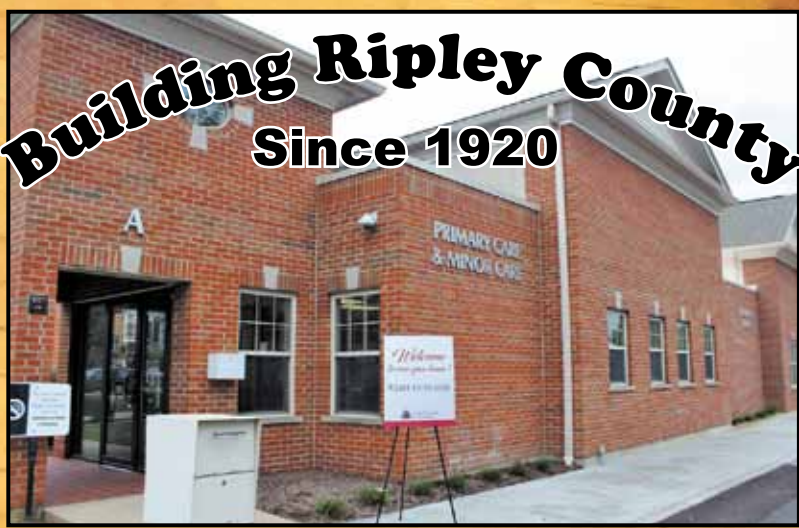
