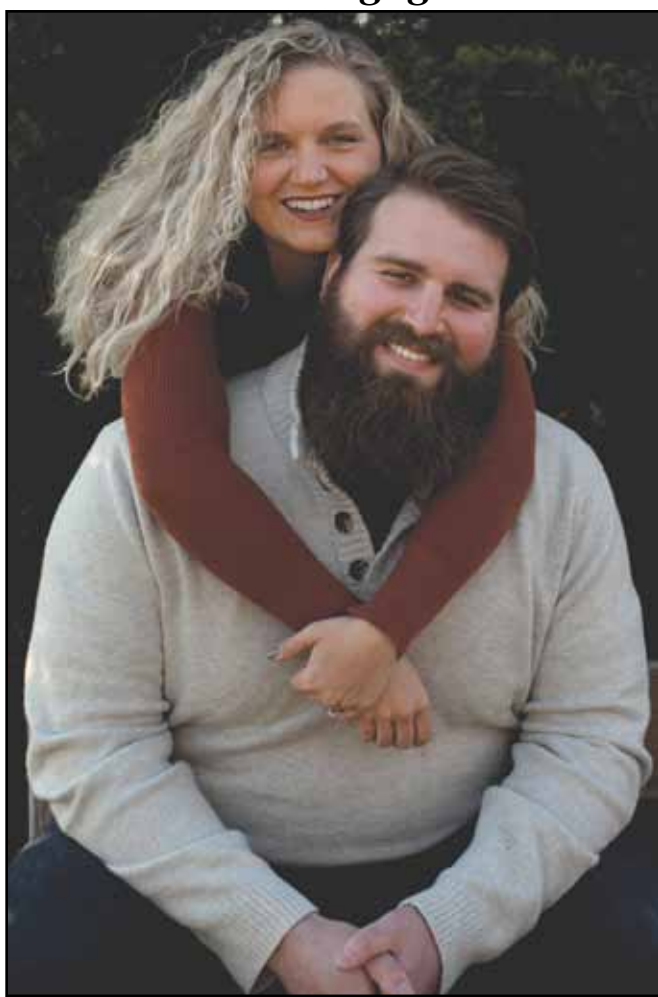

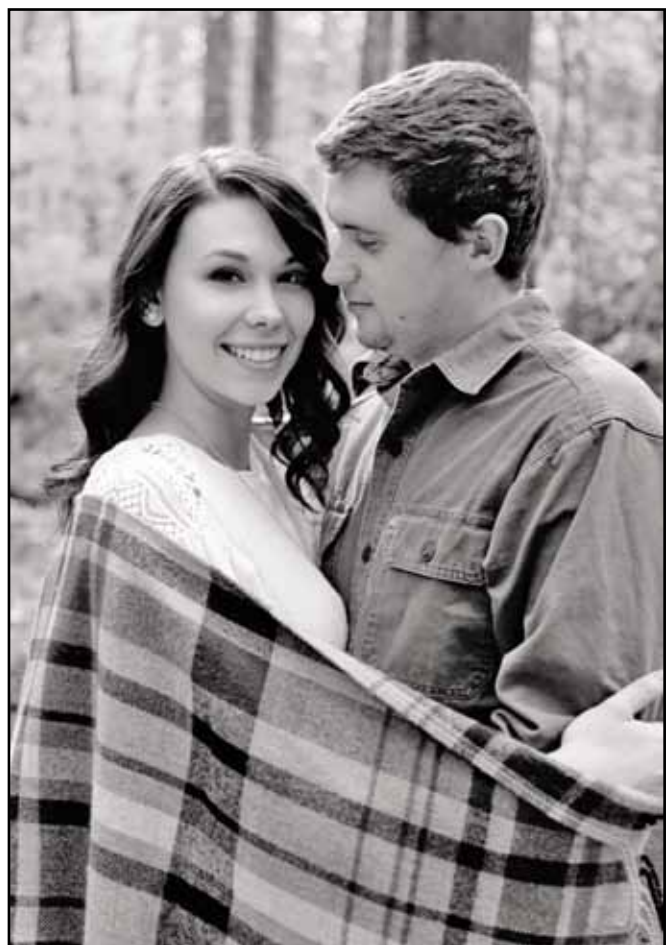

## Should We Combine Our Bank Accounts?

Your spouse may then access your account information and funds if the situation meets your predetermined power of attorney agreement on file with your bank.

### Open a main joint account and separate spending accounts.

Who says you can't have the best of both options? In this scenario, a couple opens joint checking and savings bank accounts. These accounts are for depositing paychecks, paying bills, and saving for shared goals. Spouses also have separate checking accounts for personal spending.

Money matters can enhance the quality of married life when intentionally managed. Schedule regular times to discuss finances. Do what works best for you as a couple. ### Honeymoon Planning Tips



- 1. Get Your Passport.** Staying at an all-inclusive resort outside the country is sometimes less expensive than state-side destinations. Having a current passport will allow you to explore a larger variety of honeymooning options.
