


SURVIVORS DAY CELEBRATION! Every year on the first Sunday

There are several things that go into a typical week's schedule, to name a few, planning cus-Next Week's Meetings

tomer orders, managing inventory levels, determining what scents to use (upcoming holidays to prepare for), selecting color choices, hand painting the bath bombs once made, mold choices for the shapes we want, etc. Once bath bombs and/or steamers are made they need to be packaged and labeled and then bagged for customer orders or photographed to be listed on Facebook for online selling. Believe it or not, probably the most time consuming part of the business occurs after the sale, the
