Ordinance

2023-03 AN ORDINANCE

TO ALTER MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS WITHIN THE INCORPORATED AREAS OF THE TOWN OF HOLTON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Holton, Indiana is responsible for the maintenance, upkeep and speed limits of highways/roads within the incorporated area of the Town of Holton, Indiana, (hereinafter "Town"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code 9-21-5-6, a local authority, in the authority's jurisdiction, may declare a reasonable and maximum speed limit on the highways/roads under its authority, regulating traffic on any highway in the Town's incorporated area (excluding U.S. Highway 50), subject to Indiana Code 9-21; and

WHEREAS, for purposes of enhancing safety on the Town's highways, it is advisable and appropriate to uniformly alter the maximum speed limit to Twenty-Five Miles Per Hour (25 M.P.H.) for all highways in the Town's incorporated area (excluding U.S. Highway 50), subject to Indiana Code 9-21-5-6.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of Holton, Indiana, hereby ordains that the maximum speed limit for all highways in the Town's incorporated area (excluding U.S. Highway 50) shall be Twenty-Five Miles Per Hour (25 M.P.H.).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon finding of a violation of this Ordinance, a penalty shall be assessed in accordance with the Indiana Code related to moving violations/ traffic regulations

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Ordinance has been adopted by the Town Board of Holton, Indiana this 8th day of November, 2023 and shall be effective thirty (30) days following the publication of this Ordinanc
