Mental Health First Aid is an evidence-based, early-intervention course that teaches participants about mental health and substance abuse challenges. One Community One Family offers both Adult and Youth Mental Health First Aid Training.

We offer training in QPR which teaches you how to recognize the warning signs of a suicide crisis and how to question, persuade, and refer someone to help. QPR is a brief, evidence-based suicide prevention training.
