Notice is hereby given that the Ripley County Board of Commissioners will receive sealed bids until the hour of 10:00 a.m. E.S.T. on Friday, December 8th, 2025 at the Office of the Ripley County Auditor, Ripley County Annex, 102 West First North Street, P.O. Box 235, Versailles, Indiana 47042, at which time all sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud during the regularly scheduled meeting of the Ripley County Commissioners, in the Ripley County Annex, Versailles, Indiana 47042 for the following materials and supplied for maintenance and repair of the county roads and bridges:

CRUSHED STONE

30,000 tons more or less as may be ordered by the Ripley County Highway Department Bid F.O.B. plant of bidder, (that may be purchased/picked up at various locations depending on distance) to include the following sizes:

2, 9, 11, 53B, DRB, Revetment Rip Rap.

1. The stone shall be subject to random sample tests at the Ripley County Highway Superintendents discretion.

Any sample that fails to meet specifications shall be subject to a 10% reduction in bid price for the volume of a material purchased on that date, or the bidder has the option to remove material purchased.

Failure of three samples may result in denial of any additional work for the remainder of the calendar year.
