According to information from Sgt. Stephen Wheelers multiple 9-1-1 calls were made earlier this week reporting a reckless drive on I-65 Southbound in Jackson County. Trooper Tia Hunt with the ISP-Versailles Post, was on patrol and was able to locate the vehicle.

Trooper Hunt was eventually able to get the vehicle stopped on I-65 in northern Scott County. When she made contact with the driver, she realized that the elderly man was disoriented and confused. He stated he was traveling home to Lafayette - approximately 100 miles in the opposite direction.

Trooper Hunt continued speaking to the man while she searched for emergency contact information for him. She eventually located contact information for his wife and son through the BMV. She transported him to a local hospital for evaluation while waiting

for family to respond to care for him.

It was reported that the elderly man was medically cleared and reunited with his family.
